

# Clean Mount Vista Cruise

I have always liked the Vista Cruise, but not the mounting hardware.

I came up with a way to mount one cleanly. I saw something similar done by Carbon\_One on the old VOL site. I just ran with that idea.

First, a Vista doesn't like to be mounted on a ISO grip. It takes up a lot of space and doesn't fit terribly well. I figured that out too.

1. I dremeled the inside of the Vista so that it fits flushly on the ISO. It actually will fit over the base of the ISO (near the switch box). You basically remove some material all around the inside half of the ISO that fits against the base of the grip.



2. Next, take the thinnest piece of rubber from the Vista kit. The kit includes a fat piece you can trim a strip off of. You actually use the strip. Wrap it around the

grip, then pull it tight. Slid the Vista on, then tighten the 3 mount bolts.



3. Now, I cut a small “L” bracket out of 1/8” aluminum. The tall part of the “L” is where the vista knob will mount. Drill this “L” at the top of the tall part of the “L”, then drill a hole big enough for the Screw in the throttle cable clamp.in the

base.



4. Remove the screw holding the catch plate for the throttle cables. Mount the “L” using this screw. Now, you have the tall part of the “L” running flat with the grip and Vista knob. Pass the M4 bolt through the knob and eye hole of the collar. Then pass the M4 through the hole in the top of the “L” and tighten. Not too tight or the Vista knob is too tight ot turn. Use some blue locktite on the M4 nut.



You're done! One clean mounted Vista cruise.
