

Sticker Removal Made “easy”?!

Those warning stickers can be ugly. Here's a good way to remove them:

1. Heat the sticker with a hair dryer.
2. After heating, carefully pull off the sticker (or as much as you can at a time)
3. Reheat and continue peeling until all the sticker is gone.
4. Use some Goo Gone (citrus based so it's ok for paint) to remove the sticky material.
5. Use a good wax and wax up at least the area where the sticker was (why not wax it all, you got the bottle out right?). **DO NOT SKIP THIS!** Your paint could fade or more easily be damaged without a good coat of wax.

NOTE: WD40 works fairly well, as well as some other types of removers. Check to make sure It'll be okay for paint.
