

Tool Kit for Bikers

The below is a compilation of members suggestions from an earlier thread on what people keep on their bike when on the road. This may be of help to new riders - feel free to add your comments/experience.

Also, if you have any of the applicable part numbers for things like fuses or headlight bulbs, please provide them.

Bike Kit

- Electrical tape
- Tire pressure gauge
- Zip ties/cable ties
- Universal screwdriver
- Extra pair of sunglasses
- Mini screwdriver that fits sunglasses
- Duct tape
- Leatherman tool
- First aid kit
- Allen wrenches
- Wrenches
- Sockets – 8mm up to 16mm
- Socket wrench
- Socket wrench extension
- Pair of pre-gapped spark plugs
- Small spool of wire
- Spare Fuses
- Spare headlight bulb
- Flashlight
- Side cut pliers

Items to add to saddlebags:

- A "foot" for the kickstand (needed for soft ground – attach a string tethered to your saddlebags so you can retrieve it as you start your bike)
- Phone list
- Emergency notification information
- Small spool of stranded wire (not solid) and crimps (used only in emergencies as vibration will ultimately destroy them) for roadside repair
- Cell phone
- \$20 cash & change
- Disposable camera
